# SWCS State Chapter Meeting, Har-Ber Village, Grove Oklahoma June 7 and 8, 2018

#### **Logistics and Potential Places to Stay**

For those who have not traveled to Grove, Oklahoma in recent years, travel time via Interstate 44 will take at least 1.5 hours (based on Mapquest) from downtown Tulsa to Grove. Har-Ber Village is about 10-12 minutes from the downtown Grove area.

#### Meeting Location (Presentations and Business meeting):

The formal meeting will take place at **Har-Ber Village**, **4404 West 20**<sup>th</sup> **St**, **Grove**, **OK 74344**; 918-786-6446; har-bervillage.com. Museum and historic village in Grove. Signs are present to point you toward Har-Ber Village from West 20<sup>th</sup> St. The meeting during the afternoon of June 7<sup>th</sup> is scheduled to take place in the semi-open Picnic Pavilion located on the left just before entering the large parking area for the Museum.

<u>For the Friday morning (June 8) field tour</u>, we will meet at 7:30 am in the parking lot of the Best Western Hotel, 120 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Grove, OK 74344.

#### **Potential Places to Stay Overnight in Grove:**

Grove maintains a number of motels, resorts, and camping areas. We have not arranged a specific block of rooms in any of these, so making your reservation early (in a timely manner) would be advisable.

The <u>Candlewyck Cove Resort</u> (Phone: 918-786-3636) or <u>candlewyckcove@yahoo.com</u> is across from the entrance to Har-ber Village and maintains some houses, a relatively small hotel, and cabins adjacent to Grand Lake. Some houses/cabins have multiple rooms and may sleep between 2 and 14 individuals. This resort also provides opportunities for rental of boats and other water craft (about 5 minutes from Har-Ber Village).
